ecbi Training and Support Programme Regional Training Workshop for Negotiators
Dar es Salaam, Tanzania 14 – 15 September 2016

On behalf of the [European Capacity Building Initiative](#) (ecbi) and the [International Institute for Environment and Development](#) (IIED), The Institute for Environment, Climate and Development Sustainability (IEDS) is pleased to announce that we are hosting a Regional Training Workshop for Negotiators which will be held in **Dar es Salaam on 14-15 September, 2016** at **Giraffe Ocean View Hotel**, Mbezi Beach (Africana Road). This is the third of the annual regional workshops and part of a four-year project that will return to Dar es Salaam each year. The first regional workshop was held in Dhaka, Bangladesh in April and the second in Dakar, Senegal in June.

Workshop Participants: We have invited participants from 20 different countries within Africa (including Ethiopia, Angola, Sao tome and Principe, Gambia, Mozambique, South Sudan, Sierra Leone, Liberia, Malawi, Lesotho, Zambia, Republique Islamique de Mauritanie, Namibia, Somali, South Africa, Uganda, Kenya, Sudan, Guinea Bissau and Tanzania).

Workshop Purpose and Outcomes: The workshop is part of *ecbi's [Training and Support Programme](#)* which aims to promote a more level playing field between government delegations in the UNFCCC negotiations, by providing training and support to developing countries. The purpose of the workshop is to help negotiators from vulnerable developing countries to improve their negotiations skills; arm them with better information, and the capacity to use it more effectively; help them develop positions with ecbi support; support women delegates, in particular, to become more active in the negotiations; and support national-level policy makers to be better informed about the UNFCCC process.

Events: The workshop will begin at 8:45hrs on the first day with the formal opening and a welcoming address by a representative from The Vice President's Office, Division of Environment-Tanzania. There will be an official group dinner and reception events on the evening of the same day from 19.45hrs. The dinner and reception events intend to be great opportunity to increase interactions and exchanges among workshop participants including invited guests from Germany Embassy in Tanzania.
